



BETTER & BETTERER HOW TO BRUSH YOUR CHIHUAHUA'S TEETH





ALWAYS REMEMBER:

FUN FOR ALL REWARDS FOR ALL (YES, HUMANS TOO!)



FIRST THINGS FIRST



Ask your vet which toothpaste to get. Ours recommended that we use one containing enzymes. ALWAYS use **DOG TOOTHPASTE**, checking the ingredients to be sure! Avoid **fluoride** and **xylitol**. BEWARE: fluoride may be added to the interdentals.Human toothpaste often contains xylitol, which is **deadly to dogs**! NEVER use human toothpaste on your dog. **Read everything**, including your peanut butter, to be safe!

The most important thing to remember is SAFTEY. Beyond that, be sure you are in the right headspace and have a LOW BAR. Let it unfold naturally. Be prepared to train, and ready to adapt your plan! Go slow!





l also would rather use a more natural peanut butter, etc.



You:

- Review your materials so you have the knowledge
- Be emotionally ready too! Don't try this when you are stressed or tired
- Have all your supplies ready
- Have your protocol ready
- Be will to adapt on the fly!
- Know your dog's "rockstar move"
- THIS WILL BE FUN FOR ALL!

Your Dog:

• Should be calm, receptive

Supplies:

- 1. Low value treat for when you're in your dogs comfort zone / slightly out of it
- 2. High value treat for when your dog stepped out of the comfort zone for you
- 3. Low value toothpaste (real doggie toothpaste) - see if your dog is cool with this
- 4. Vet-approved dog toothpaste
- 5. Interdentals standard or wide (NO fluoride)
- 6. Napkins, paper towels

START WITH A LOW BAR + RAISE IT SLOWLY + GRADUALLY

• Touching the head gently (from various angles)

- Touching the side of face gently
- Touching OUTER mouth gently (I use the verbal "Mommy touches you" when I touch their mouths); Give praise and treats for this!

Choose your own "verbal," meaning say whatever you like, and plan to stick with it!

Med

Low

- Stroking/Touching OUTER mouth gently with "Mommy touches you," or whatever your verbal is GIVE TREAT!
- Gently touching inside the mouth, saying verbal TREAT!
- Trying different angles, saying verbal TREAT!
- Dog's checking out the toothbrush TREAT! (Try to avoid licks and bites. You just want your dog to get excited to see the toothbrush.)
- You gently touching the side of your dog's mouth with the toothbrush in your hand (or touching your dog with the non-bristly end of the toothbrush), saying verbal TREAT!
- High
- Toothbrush in mouth barely in mouth to start. TREAT! (I start with no paste, but with shyer dogs I may have dog food gravy on my fingers.)
- Toothbrush on an easy-access tooth TREAT!
- Toothbrush brushes an easy-access tooth TREAT!
- Add toothpaste and brush that easy-access tooth TREAT!

Gradually -- very gradually -- brush different OR more teeth.

Keep it:

- Safe
- Slow
- Short
- Positive
- Fun for all

End on a high note and reward yourself too!

Switch to a **rockstar move** (like "touch" or "sit") if your dog isn't ready for a new ask. Give a **jackpot** when your dog triumphs over something tricky!

EXAMPLES

Bella is "into it"



"Mommy touches you" - started low bar and then got more in her mouth



Added in the dry toothbrush - first without brushing and then brushed a LITTLE



Added toothpaste - low bar brushing on an easy access tooth



Started brushing more teeth, even the back molar took it SLOW

Bella was on the fast track, so I took her cues. When I raised the bar a bit higher I switched to the higher value treats for her. I gave her lots of praise too!

> You can always lower the bar, up the treat value, STOP, or ask for a rockstar move!

Tried some "Mommy touches you" but backed off...




Rockstar move!
